Changes to road closures Downtown Streetfest 2018

What's changed?

The City of Burlington is adding new safety features to Brant Street to strengthen the barriers between pedestrians and vehicle and avoid incidents of "ramming". Concrete barriers will be placed, on Brant Street, at key intersections between Lakeshore Road and Caroline. (see attached MAP)

When will the road closures take place?

To prepare for Downtown Streetfest 2018 **Brant Street** will be:

CLOSED: Friday, June 15th at 3:30pm

RE-OPENED: Sunday, June 17th at approx. 7:00pm

*parts of Lakeshore Road will also be temporarily closed between 10:30pm - midnight on Friday, June 15th & Saturday, June 16th as police usher Festival goers out of Spencer Smith Park after final performances.

How do I get access to my Brant Street business?

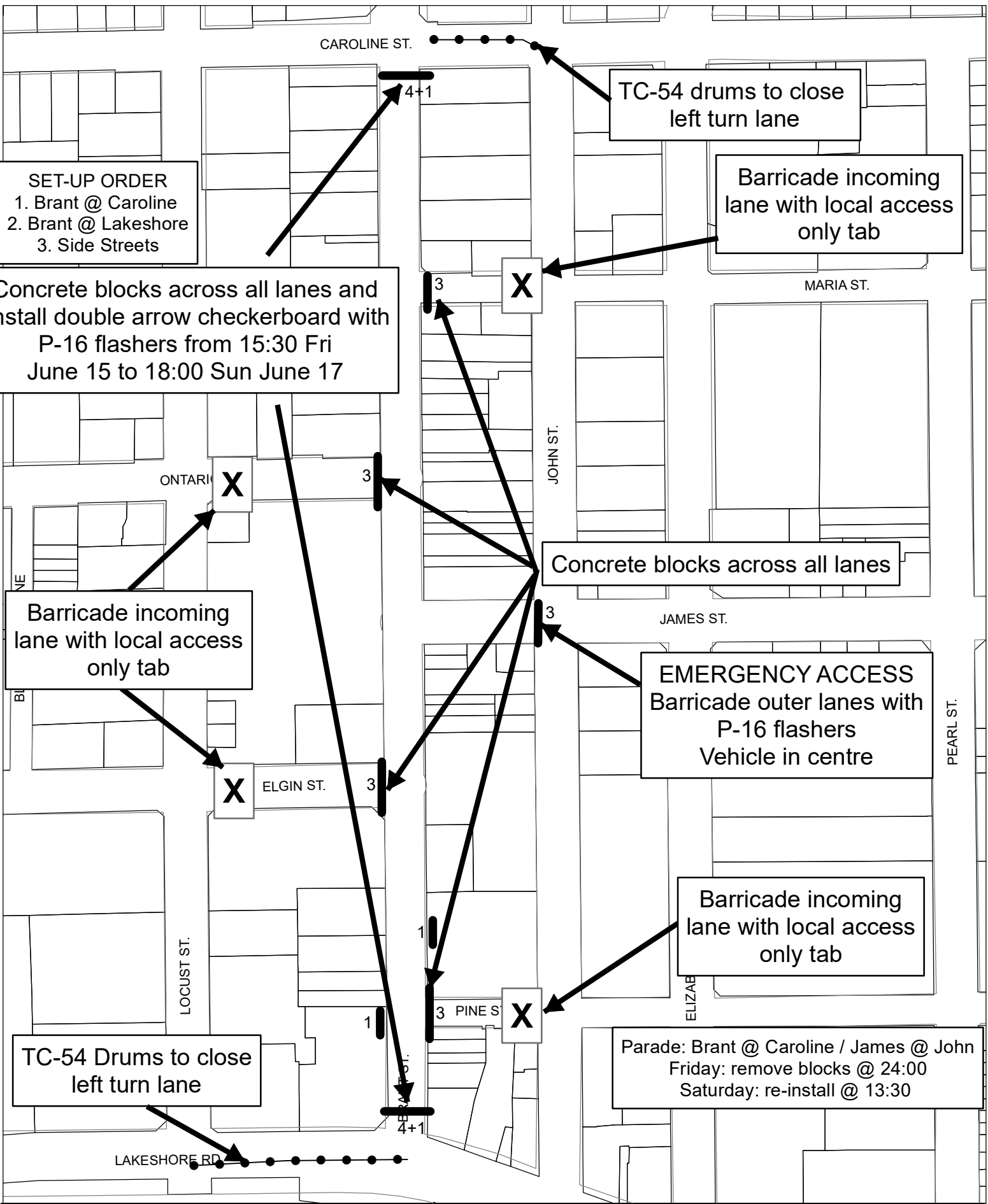
With the exception of Parade on Saturday, June 16th (from 10:30 am - 1:00pm) Brant Street will be closed to vehicles all weekend. Emergency Services will be removing the barricades on:

Saturday, June 17th from 6-8 am

Sunday, June 18th from 6-8 am

Access to Brant Street will be at the intersection of James & John Street for you, your employees and suppliers during this time only.
